A County member resides outside a 20 mile radius of the club house or due to their employment, lives away for long periods of time.

All applications are subject to committee approval and should be accompanied by the appropriate membership fee. Where it has been agreed that the member pays by instalments they should note that should they decide to discontinue their membership before the end of the year, they must give one months notice and pay all applicable instalments.

Racking is subject to the approval of the Captain of Boats/Commodore of Canoes.
